



Marius Potgieter is an active member of the Centre of Excellence in Space Research at the North-West University in Potchefstroom. He is Professor of Physics specializing in computational aspects and modelling of Space Physics, Heliospace Physics and Cosmic Rays in the Galaxy and Heliosphere. He spent time as a postdoctoral fellow at NASA's Goddard Space Flight Center in Greenbelt, Maryland, and as visiting professor in France, Germany, Italy, Switzerland and the USA. He was a guest scientist on the Ulysses Mission, funded by ESA & NASA and has close collaborations with teams on the VOYAGER (USA) and PAMELA (Italy) space missions, and groups in Germany. He served on the organizing committees of many international conferences and workshops, such as COSPAR and the International Cosmic Ray Conference. He is presently the chairperson of the SA National COSPAR committee and represents South Africa on the COSPAR Council. He was the principal investigator of one of the first flagship research project on Computational Space Physics and Astrophysics, supported through the CHPC from 2007-2009. He has an A1 rating from the NRF.
