



Fourie Joubert was educated at the University of Pretoria, where he completed a PhD in Biochemistry in 2000.

He co-founded the Bioinformatics and Computational Biology Unit in 2003. He was promoted to Professor at the beginning of 2012. He is currently the Director of the Bioinformatics and Computational Biology Unit, which has 5 staff members and around 20 post-graduate students.

He has an NRF C2-rating, and has published around 45 research papers and book chapters. He is a founding member of the South African Society for Bioinformatics and Computational Biology.

His current research focusses on breast cancer genomics, including germ line and somatic variant investigation in South African breast cancer patients.
